HAVE A QUESTION

What are the requirements to enter the Palmetto Center for the Arts?

Students must be rising freshmen in Richland School District Two and complete an application process that includes acceptance to a specific arts area by audition. Sophomores who have recently moved to Richland Two may also audition.

Where is the school located?

Palmetto Center for the Arts (PCA) is the District's only visual and performing arts magnet, and it is housed at the Richland Northeast International Baccalaureate World School, located in Richland School District Two at 7500 Brookfield Road, Columbia, SC 29223.

Is transportation provided?

No, transportation is not provided unless the student lives in the area zoned to Richland Northeast. Students living outside the Richland Northeast zone must provide their own transportation.

For what art areas may students audition?

Students may audition for dance, music (vocal, band, and strings), theatre and visual arts.

What does the audition process involve?

Audition requirements are based on state guidelines for each arts discipline, and require completion of an application and an audition that includes a performance or portfolio demonstration of the student's potential, as well as recommendations from a teacher and a guidance counselor. Auditions will be adjudicated by a panel of professionals. The decision of the judges is final. Natural talent, prior training, level of interest in and commitment to the arts are evaluated. Previous training or experience is not required to be accepted.

When and where will the auditions be held?

All PCA Auditions will be held at Richland Northeast High School. Theatre and Vocal auditions will be held Tuesday, February 13, 2018 after school at an assigned time, and the audition will take about ten minutes. Visual Arts auditions will take place Thursday, Feb. 15, from 4:00-5:30 pm, and students will need to be there the entire time. Band and String auditions will be held Tuesday, Feb. 20, after school at an assigned time, and the audition will take about ten minutes. Dance auditions will be held Wednesday, February 21, from 4:00-5:30 pm, and students will need to be there the entire time. Students will be notified of their assigned time for band, strings, theatre and vocal auditions after the application process closes on Jan. 31st. Please make sure that your email address on your application is accurate.

Are students permitted to audition for more than one art area?

Yes, students may audition for as many as three art areas, but can be accepted into only one. Students auditioning for multiple art areas must indicate their preference on the application by ranking their choice of art areas as 1st, 2nd or 3rd.

What is required of students accepted into the arts magnet?

Students accepted into the arts magnet must earn a minimum of 6 arts credits in their major arts area. They must also complete a senior project and an extended-hours requirement to be determined by instructors in each arts discipline. PCA students who complete all requirements of the arts magnet will receive a fine arts certification with their diploma upon graduation.

Can students maintain a full academic schedule while studying the arts?

Yes. As a fully accredited, twice-named Blue Ribbon School of Excellence, Richland Northeast offers a rigorous and challenging academic program of studies which includes honors-level and 25 Advanced Placement courses, as well as a college preparatory curriculum. **In addition, all PCA students will automatically have the extraordinary benefit of being enrolled in the prestigious and world-renowned International Baccalaureate (IB) programme through the upper level arts courses. PCA students will complete an IB level arts course and will also have the opportunity to pursue the IB Diploma.**

Richland Northeast has received many honors, most recently being named an International Baccalaureate World School. In addition, Richland Northeast was named a Creative Ticket National School of Distinction by the John F. Kennedy Center. Many colleges and universities across the nation look to our school for potential students.

There is also mounting evidence that the arts benefit student achievement on standardized tests. According to the *College Board, Profile of SAT and Achievement Test Takers*, "arts students outperform non-arts students on SAT." **Data from the College Board show that students who took four years of arts and music classes while in high school scored 102 points better on their SATs than students who took only one-half year or less.** Source: *The College Board, 2010. 2010 College-Bound Seniors: Total Group Profile Report.*

Can students in another Northeast magnet participate in the arts magnet?

Yes. Richland Northeast High School offers **dual magnet participation**. Students in Horizon or Convergence Media may also participate in PCA. Students wishing to participate in two magnets at Northeast, however, must apply for both PCA and Horizon or Convergence Media.

How can I become a candidate for the Palmetto Center for the Arts?

Admission is by application and audition. Interested students are asked to apply for the Palmetto Center for the Arts online at www.richland2.org. Online applications will be accepted from December 12, through January 31, 2018. A link to PCA audition requirements is available on the application site. **Be sure to check the audition requirements of each art area for which you wish to audition.**
